Prevent hepatitis A and B

- Hepatitis A and B infect a person's liver.
- Vaccination is a safe and effective way to avoid these diseases.
 - Everyone who uses blood products, as well as those who administer them, should get vaccinated against hepatitis A and B if they don't already have immunity.
- But remember: people with hemophilia need to avoid intramuscular injections and receive them subcutaneously.
